## Notes:

1. A Shooters Certificate of Competency (SCC) is required for shooters to use NRA or MOD controlled ranges. It is not permitted for shooters to fire at a range unless a) in possession of a current SCC or b) being directly supervised on a one-to-one basis by somebody who does.
2. The NRA is the only organisation to issue SCC cards. NRA affiliated clubs may request SCC cards on behalf of members.
3. The HBSA can request a SCC on your behalf. If you are a current NRA Member there is no charge for this. If however you are not an NRA member then the NRA makes a charge to the HBSA of **£9.75** for the issue of each card.
4. SCC cards requested via this route are normally valid for the current year. There is no pro-rata or full refund available for any reason.
5. If for any reason the HBSA ceases to affiliate to the NRA, then the SCCs issued via the HBSA cease to be valid.
6. If for any reason you leave the HBSA or fail to renew your membership your SCC will cease to be valid. According to the NRA terms of the issue of SCCs the HBSA is compelled to report you as having left the HBSA.
7. If your FAC or SGC is revoked we are also compelled to inform the NRA of this.
8. The HBSA cannot issue SCC for non HBSA Members.
9. The HBSA can only issue SCC cards for members who it deems suitably safe and familiar with the NRA safe system of shooting in relevant categories. Please indicate the categories you wish to be certified for overleaf.
10. If you are an existing NRA member then they will use the details they have on file as well as your photo.
11. If you are not an NRA member please be aware that in order to request the issue of an SCC on your behalf, we will forward your full name, address, date of birth, email address, telephone number and a digital photo. 12. If you are not an NRA member and also have other categories of arms to be fired on NRA and/or MOD ranges, you may wish to consult any other NRA affiliated club you are also a member of in order to avoid paying more than once.
