

## Reilly-Comblain 2-band Military Rifle



**Calibre:** .577" Snider  
**Barrel length:** 31½"  
**Serial no.:** 1149  
**Date:** 1868



This tip-up action was patented in 1867 by H. Haschke. (no.2,778). An extremely rare rifle, the curved lever on the right of the receiver is rotated anti-clockwise, and in one movement, unlocks the breech, withdraws the breech block from the barrel, tilts the block up, extracts and ejects the fired case and cocks the hammer.
